Family Shelter Service Position Description

Position: Part-Time Bi-lingual (Spanish/English) Therapist/Counselor

Summary: Provides counseling and support services to Latina/o clients. Promotes self-reliance through an empathic and caring atmosphere.

Duties & Responsibilities:

1. Provides individual counseling and support services to Spanish-speaking clients which include case management, advocacy, and some helpline support. Provides services at different FSS locations as needed.
2. Answers Spanish-language helpline calls. Provides counseling, support, advocacy and referrals to callers as necessary. Monitors and returns messages left in the Spanish- language helpline voice-mail account.
3. Conducts intake interviews with clients and their families, including pre-group interviews.
4. Facilitates support and educational groups.
5. Assists during special events for clients.
6. Prepares proper documentation of services for all client files (case notes, intakes, etc.). Completes all necessary paperwork.
7. Participates in training for agencies and community groups.
8. Participates in CCS team meetings, Spanish-Language Services Committee and supervision.
9. Attends FSS and community committees as needed.
10. Remains cognizant of current developments in the field of domestic violence.
11. Performs other duties as reasonably assigned.

Relationships:

1. Supervised by the Director of Counseling and Community Services and Latina Program Coordinator.
2. Works with agency interns and volunteers as needed.
3. Establishes and maintains contact with community agencies and organizations as appropriate.
4. Collaborates with bilingual staff within agency across programs.
5. Participates in Spanish Language Services Committee meetings.

Qualifications and Characteristics:

1. Bilingual: Must be bilingual in Spanish/English with bicultural preferred.
